16 PSSonline: Grade1-2



- ➤ Combination of Online (Moodle, E-books, weekly classes)
- Facilitation: Grade 1-2 students must be based in Swakopmund as they need the faceto-face. Students will also receive a stationery list, necessary to complete each subject.
- ➤ Term 1: Afternoon Facilitation will be 3 times a week to help ensure the Phonics, Reading programme and Mathematics is taught and applied correctly
- Term 2 and 3: Afternoon facilitation will be 2 times a week to ensure the students continue progression and will help to assess student's progress.
- ➤ Subjects: Mathematics, English, Science, Global perspectives

- Students will receive an Objective sheet for the week with Objectives for each subject, homework as well as projects that need to be completed. This can be done flexibly as long as weekly objectives are reached to be able to progress to the next week. Students will also receive a stationery list, necessary to complete each subject.

- Students will receive an Objective sheet for the week with Objectives for each subject, homework as well as projects that need to be completed. This can be done flexibly as long as weekly objectives are reached to be able to progress to the next week. Students will also receive a stationery list, necessary to complete each subject.

PSSonline: Visiting week



➤ Our online students are invited to visit the PSS for the 1st week of the year (Orientation week) to meet their teacher and learn about Moodle and to set goals for themselves.

- Grade 3-6 Receive academic reports, indicating progress:

40% Prepared assessments

- This will help ensure that students can apply their skills learned especially when unprepared.
